The Candidate will be responsible for various tasks, both for programs and for organisational Development. These tasks include:

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- Working with the team on community mobilization and organizing.
- Conducting information campaign, community monitoring of public program implementation, facilitating application preparation of community members and interface with government officials for early sanction of benefits.
- Conduct training programs for Citizen Leaders and Gram Panchayat representatives.
- Maintain MIS both in manual and electronic formats.
- Actively work with the team in planning and reviewing the project activities as per the outcome matrix.
- Documentation (print, photo and video) of project processes and success stories; record and develop innovative interactive learning methods.
- Support in timely reporting to the donor and other organizations.
- Coordinate appropriate welfare and protection safeguards for the communities as and when necessary, as the pandemic is ongoing.
